The construction of our new Astro Turf facility starting shortly at a cost of €180,000.

This will be a great facility for our families (young and old) and our schools and wider community of Moynalvey/Summerhill. This facility will be suitable for games hurling/football for our youngsters and lawn bowls for our older parishioners. Some details on where we are so far:

We tendered for Astro Turf and got prices for Astro Turf-Fencing-Lighting-Ball Stop nets. The GAA then put in a stipulation that every Astro Turf going forward must have a shock-pad system underneath the Astro turf and this costs an additional €30,000 which put us over budget. We contacted the Department and explained our situation and they agreed to allow us exclude the lighting part of the project in order to include the shock-pad which now must be included.

The Department said we could apply for a lighting grant on the next round of applications which opens shortly. We are going to put in all the ducting for the lighting at this stage to leave it easier when we get next grant.

Our fundraising is very important to leave us in a position to do lighting phase.



Since Covid, it's proving difficult to keep our clubhouse open, we certainly don't want to lose this superb facility which most clubs would love to have.
